

The TwinEagles Club Dress Code

July 2023

The Dress Code is meant to make it easy for all Members and their guests to experience and enjoy all TwinEagles has to offer in a modern Southwest Florida private golf and country club environment.

Clubhouse Dress Code

The TwinEagles Clubhouse provides multiple dining opportunities, diversity of events, and hours of operation for all Members and their guests. To make it easy for all to experience and enjoy multiple activities and events, a *minimum requirement for proper attire* has been defined as TwinEagles Country Club Casual. Modes of dress that are more formal than TwinEagles Country Club Casual are always acceptable.

Required attire/dress code for events in the Clubhouse may vary by theme/specific event. The dress for these events will be specified by the Club in your registration, event flyers, and communications related to the specific event. When a member registers themselves and/or a guest for an event, they agree to the dress code for the event as part of their registration.

TwinEagles Country Club Casual - Defined

Men/Boys:

Collared shirts, dress slacks or Bermuda length shorts, worn with belt or suspenders. Dress denim in good condition is acceptable. Dress denim excludes Levi's/Wrangler or similar style blue jeans. Shirts will be tucked in unless they are designed to not be tucked in.

Examples of inappropriate attire for men include, but are not limited to, denim that is torn, frayed, bleached, dye-washed or has holes, tee shirts, sleeveless shirts, cargo shorts, cargo pants, fitness apparel, cut-off or athletic shorts, jams, swimsuits, tank tops and fishnet shirts.

Sandals and open-toed footwear are not permitted anywhere inside the clubhouse after 5:00pm, except for the Men's Locker Room, Golf Shop and Café.

Hats are not to be worn in the Clubhouse at any time, except for the locker room, Golf Shop and Café.

Golf shoes with metal spikes are not allowed for golf or in any Club Facility. Removable spiked shoes are not allowed in the Clubhouse except for the Men's Locker Room, Golf Shop and Café. Spikeless golf shoes are acceptable.

Women/Girls:

Dresses, skirts, slacks, capris, shorts of mid-thigh length at minimum. Dress denim in good condition is acceptable. Dress denim excludes Levi's/Wrangler or similar style blue jeans.

Examples of inappropriate attire for women include, but are not limited to, denim that is torn, frayed, bleached, dye washed or has holes, crop tops, fishnet tops, bathing suits, sweatpants, tennis dresses, athletic shorts, cargo shorts and fitness apparel.

Women are permitted to wear hats in the Clubhouse before 5:00pm.

Golf shoes with metal spikes are not allowed for golf or in any Club Facility. Removable spiked shoes are not allowed in the Clubhouse except for the Ladies' Locker Room, Golf Shop and Café.

Banquet Room

All day – TwinEagles Country Club Casual

A La Carte Dining Room (includes outside bar and Terrace)

All day - TwinEagles Country Club Casual

Private Dining Room

All day – Dress code set appropriately (TwinEagles Country Club Casual is a minimum) by Staff and Member organizer.

Café

The Café is expected to serve golfers, bocce players, tennis/pickleball players, walkers, Members using the Himalayan Golf Course and firepits, and Members just passing by.

Before 5:00 p.m. – TwinEagles Country Club Casual plus clothing outlined in this policy for Golf, Bocce, Tennis and Pickleball. Hats and open-toed shoes are allowed.

After 5:00 p.m. – TwinEagles Country Club Casual

Golf, Golf Practice Areas (Driving Range, Practice Greens, Chipping Areas)

Men

Slacks or shorts of mid-thigh length or longer with a collared shirt. All shirts must be tucked in and not hung-over pants or shorts. Hats or visors are permitted in the Men's locker room, the Golf Shop, and the Cafe. Hats must always be worn forward. Outside wear may include sweaters, pullovers, jackets, and rain gear.

Examples of inappropriate attire include but are not limited to sleeveless shirts, tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cargo pants or shorts, cut-offs, sweatpants, denim of any color or style, bathing suits, tennis shorts, or other athletic shorts that are not designed for golf.

Women

Dresses, skirts, slacks, golf-length shorts/skirts of mid-thigh length or longer, and blouses with collars and/or sleeves are considered appropriate attire. Women's sleeveless shirts must have a collar. Outside wear, such as sweaters, pullovers, jackets, or rain gear are permitted. Women are permitted to wear hats anywhere in TwinEagles.

Examples of inappropriate golf attire for women include but are not limited to halter tops, crop tops, tank tops, fishnet tops, bathing suits, sweatpants, denim of any color or style, tennis dresses, tennis or pickleball length skirts/skort, athletic shorts, cargo shorts, cut-offs. No leggings or tights are permitted unless worn under other proper golf attire (i.e. a mid-thigh or longer skirt/skort).

Shoes

Appropriate non-metal spike, or spike less golf shoes are required on the golf course. The wearing of shoes other than golf shoes (shoes designed for golf use) must be approved by the Golf Professional Team. Golf shoes with metal spikes are not allowed anywhere on the Club property, including Golf Course, Golf Practice areas or any Club Facility. Removable non-metal spiked shoes are not allowed in the Clubhouse except for the Ladies and Men's Locker Rooms, Golf Shop and Café.

Bocce

TwinEagles Country Club Casual. No high heels or shoes with any kind of spike on the Bocce courts.

Himalayan Golf Course

TwinEagles Country Club Casual. Appropriate non-metal spike, or no spike golf shoes are required. High heeled shoes are not allowed.

Tennis

Suitable tennis clothes are items of clothing designed specifically for tennis and sold in tennis shops. Men shall wear tennis shirts with sleeves. Tennis shoes meant for clay courts are required. No street, running or other shoes with heavy traction soles may be worn.

Inappropriate attire includes crop tops, tank tops, cut-offs, jams, denim of any color, bathing suits, cargo pants, or cargo shorts. Clothing that is torn or in need of cleaning or repair is not appropriate.

Pickleball

Comfortable tennis or athletic clothing is appropriate (collars not required). Court shoes with stabilization are recommended to prevent injury.

Inappropriate attire includes crop tops, tank tops, cut-offs, jams, denim of any color or style, bathing suits, cargo pants, or cargo shorts. Attire that is torn and/or in need of cleaning or repair, is not appropriate.

Fitness Center

Casual workout attire is acceptable at the Fitness Center, such as tee-shirts, tank tops, gym shorts or warm-up pants for men, and leotards, tights, tee shirts, tank tops, gym shorts or warm-up pants for women. Swimsuits and sports bras are not permitted in the Fitness Center, other than the locker rooms. Only running, aerobic and court shoes may be worn in the Fitness Center. Open toed and street shoes are not permitted.

Tiki Bar and pool complex

The Tiki Bar is intended to be a more relaxed area for gathering. Athletic and golf attire, denim, t-shirts with sleeves and swimwear (as reviewed below) are permitted. Examples of inappropriate attire include but are not limited to, denim that is torn, frayed, bleached, dye washed or has holes, crop tops, fishnet tops, tank tops, sleeveless T-shirts.

Men

Swim trunks or Speedo-type briefs only. Cut-offs, shorts with zippers, bicycle shorts, exposed underwear or street clothes are not permitted for swimming. Men must wear a shirt with sleeves and footwear while in the Tiki bar area.

Women

Appropriate swimsuits are 1-piece full coverage or 2-piece full coverage (bikini or tankini) swimsuits. No thong swimsuits or exposed underwear (including sports bras) are permitted. Swimsuits should be tasteful and modest. Street clothes are not permitted for swimming. Tight fitting cotton or spandex/sun-proof) shirts, shorts or pants may be worn over a swimsuit for swimming as needed. Women must wear a coverup over swimwear and footwear while in the Tiki bar area.

Children and Infants

Infants must wear swimsuit bottoms with a swim diaper. Children, who are not potty trained, are required to wear swim diapers with their swimsuit.

Additional Information

Any Member or guest who does not follow the TwinEagles dress code will be asked to correct it by a TwinEagles Leadership TEAM member, or they will not be allowed to participate/dine.
